

Riding up to the Clarence River and the St. James Conservation Area

It takes 2-2.5 hours (walking) to ride up to St James Conservation Area from Hanmer Springs following the Jacks Pass Pack Track (see Jacks Pass – Jollies Pass Circuit). At the road intersection, turn left and continue along the road to reach the St James Homestead. DOC information on the St James Conservation Area You can camp at the St James Homestead and access the many rides in the Conservation Area from there. See descriptions of the facilities and rides in the section Trek the High Country. Contact us if you wish to park your horse float in Hanmer, although, as yet, we have no knowledge of vandalism or theft of vehicles and floats being left anywhere in the Clarence Valley at St James Homestead or Fowlers Hut.
